- Also for the children (James and Sanjay) who are appearing for public board exams more personal tutoring happens for them.


This Teacher's Day, she was appreciated and commended by the Headmistress of the school for her dedication and hard work.

Theboral → teaches at the Police Club center. She teaches all the subjects for students in various grades.






Devika → teaches at KP Park. Last year she was instrumental in 2 of our students passing their 10th boards. She teaches all subjects for students in various groups.
