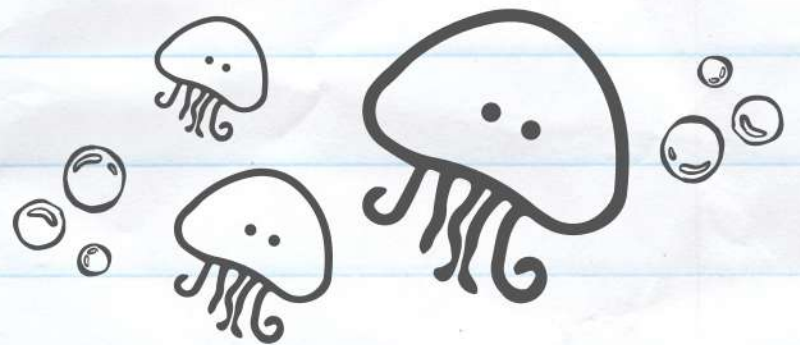
F-14 POLICE CLUB

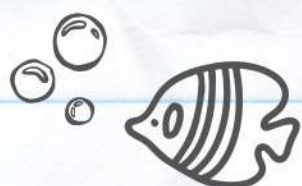
WEEKLY LEARNING

STUDENTS GROWTH

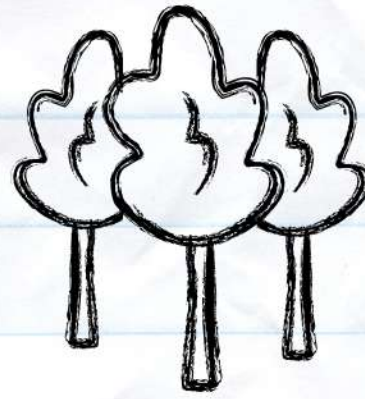

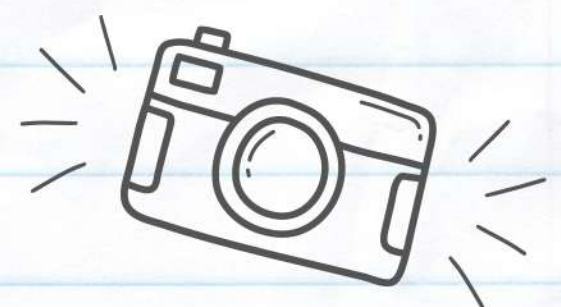

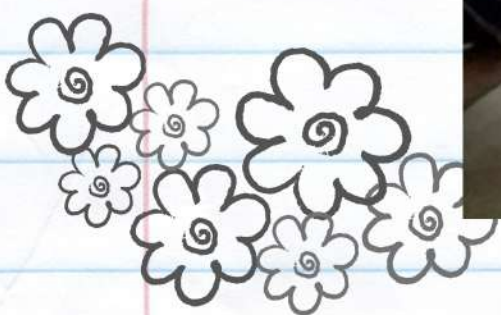
ART CLASS

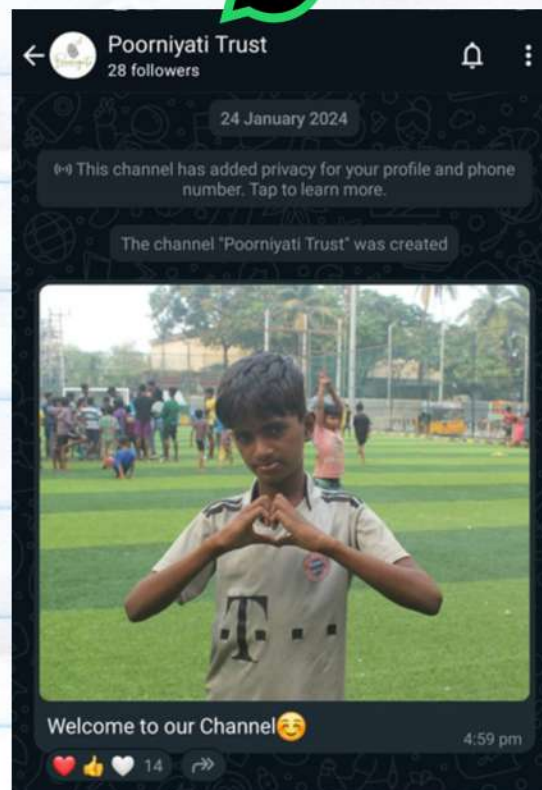
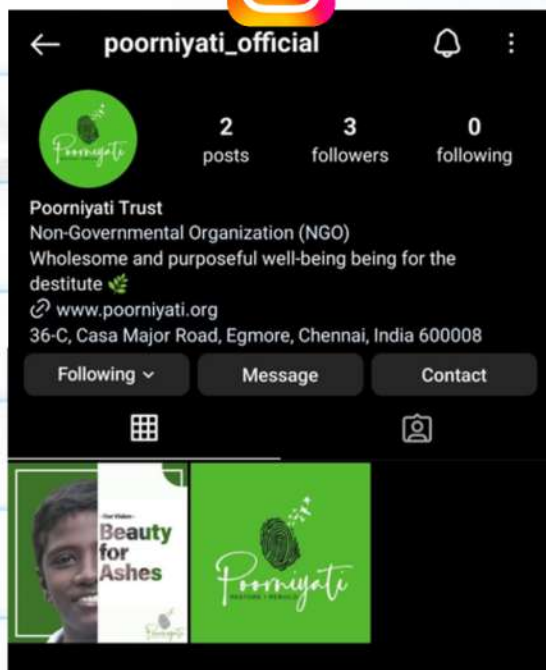

Devika → teaches at KP Park. This year she was instrumental in one of our students passing their 10th boards. She teaches all subjects for students in various groups.

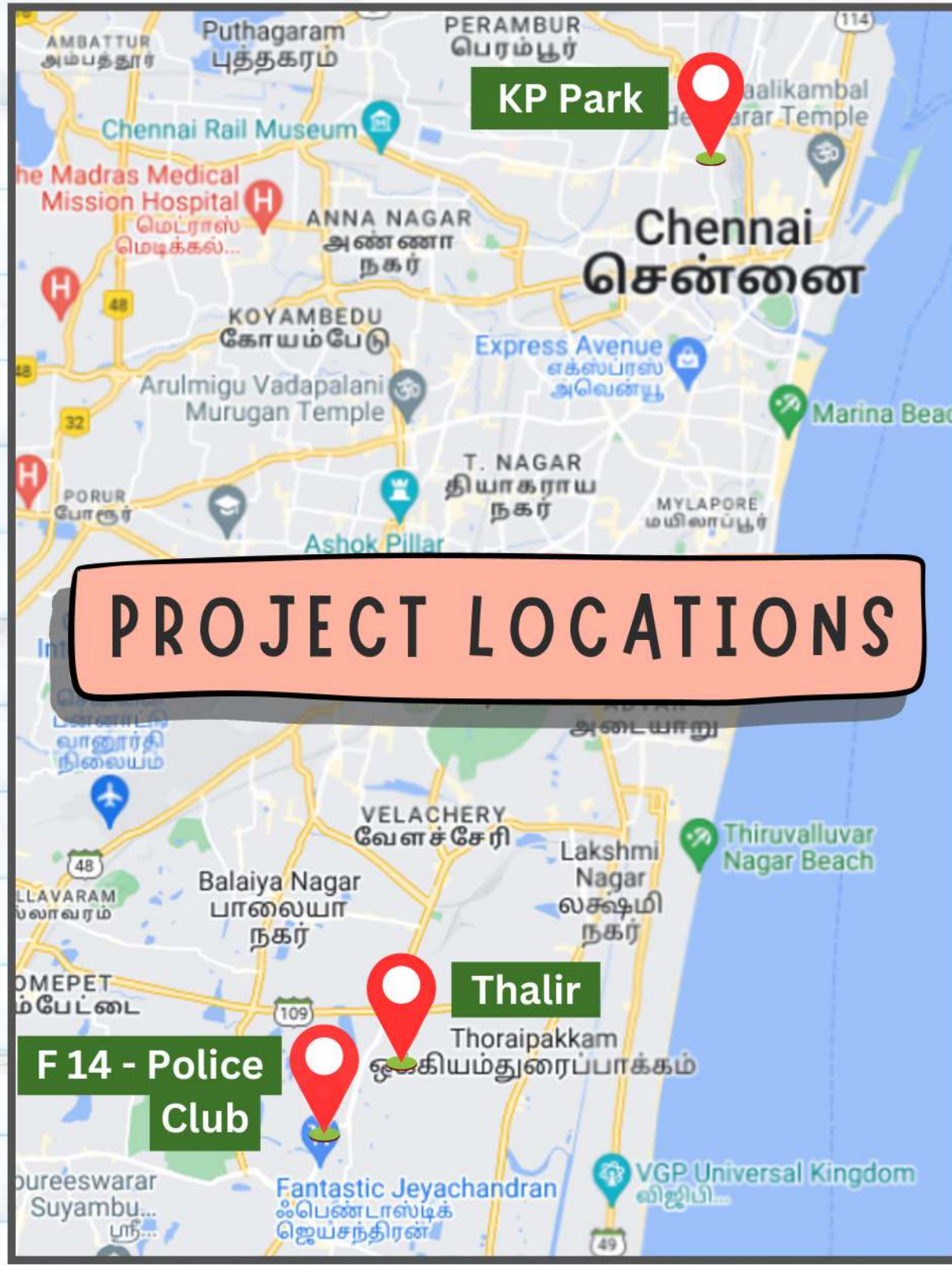
