- The children eagerly look forward to learn from teacher Theboral.



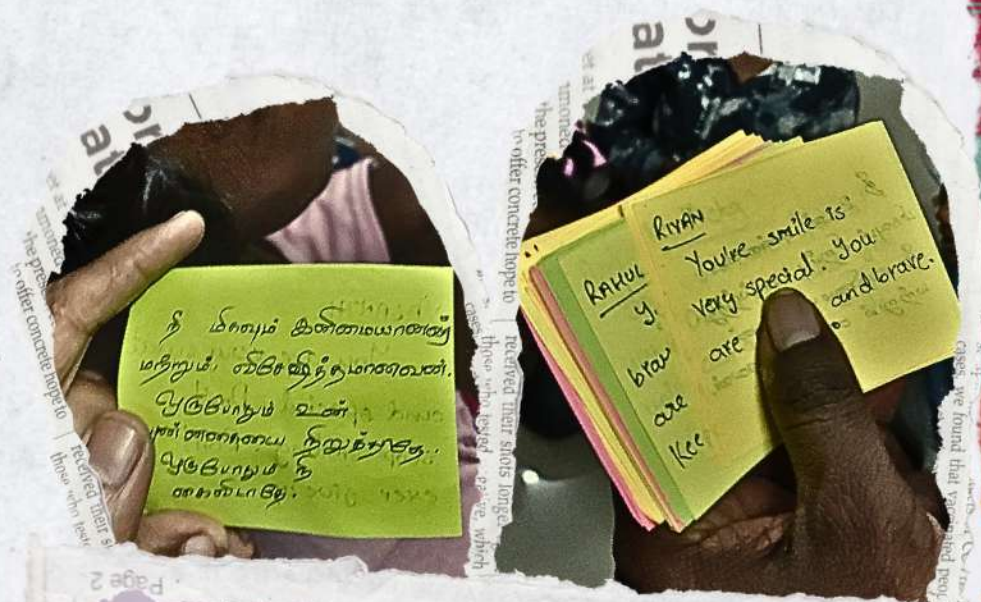

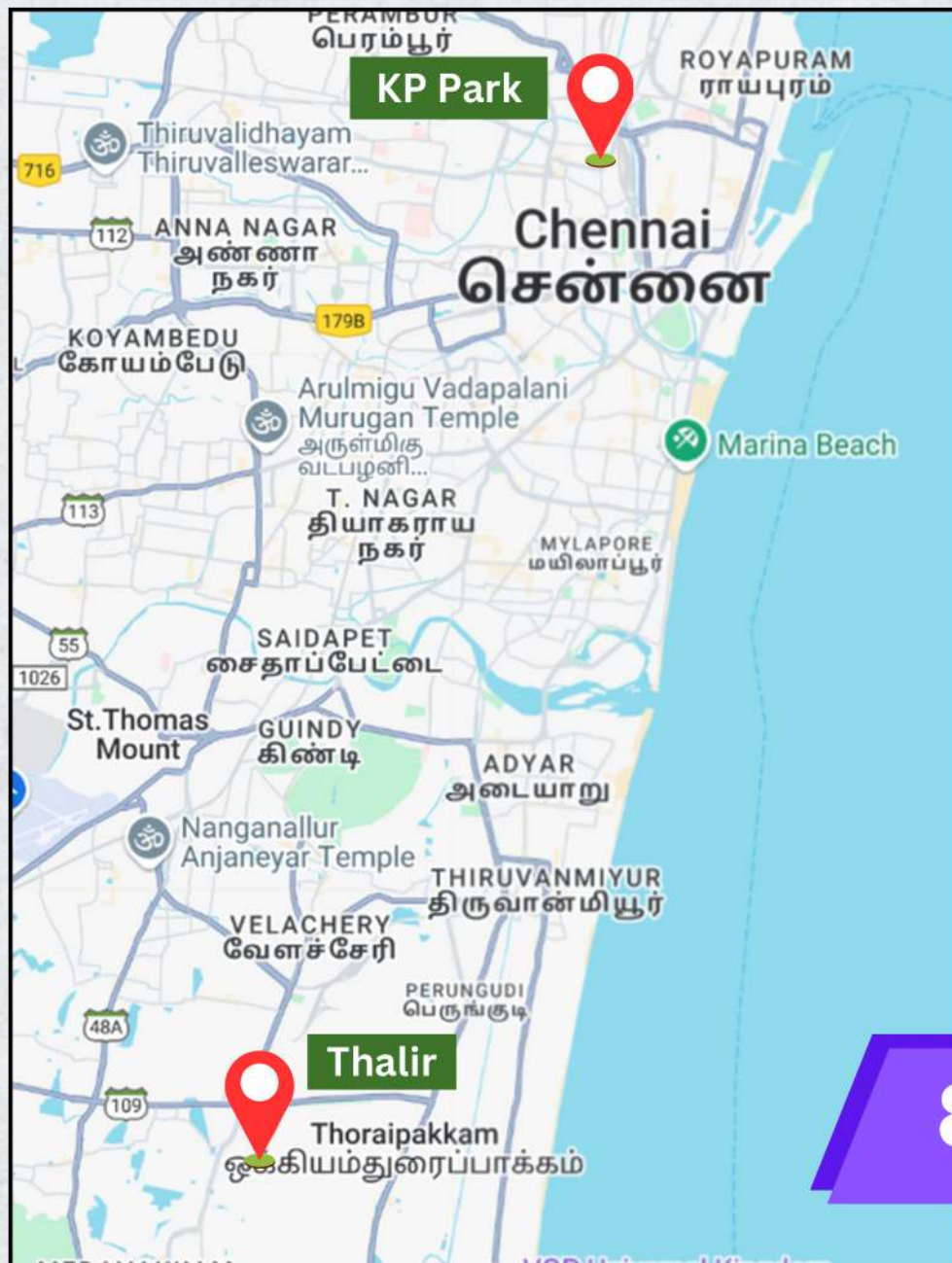
Ramya → is our teacher at KP Park tuitions. She teaches all subjects and takes care of the maintenance of the centre
